

Kamla Park/Kamlapati Mahal

Overlooking the Upper Lake, reflects Bhopal's rich heritage with its historic charm. A serene spot blending history and scenic beauty.

Gauhar Mahal (550 mtr)

Qudsia Begum built her first castle Gauhar Mahal (1819–1837) overlooking the Upper Lake, blending Hindu and Mughal architecture across 4.65 acres. This historic structure, with its winding passages and steep stairs, offers stunning lake views and reflects Bhopal's royal legacy.

Iqbal Maidan (200 mtr)

Iqbal Maidan offers a striking view of the Indo-Gothic Shaukat Mahal and the grand Moti Mahal, reflecting Bhopal's royal architectural legacy.

Taj-ul-Masajid (01 km)

Taj-ul-Masajid in Bhopal is one of the largest mosques in India, showcasing stunning Mughal architecture. A symbol of grandeur and spiritual significance, it stands as a heritage masterpiece.

• Gol Ghar Museum (01 km)

Known for its unique round-shaped architecture, Gol Ghar in Bhopal was originally built as a granary. It now houses a museum showcasing artifacts that highlight the region's cultural and historical evolution.



BHOPAL-UDAIGIRI-SANCHI-BHOPAL (AFTERNOON TOUR)

Sanchi: A Buddhist Heritage Site

Sanchi, a small town in Madhya Pradesh's Raisen district, is famous for its ancient Buddhist monuments. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is Located 64 kms from Bhopal and is easily accessible by road and rail.

The Buddhist monuments at Sanchi were influenced by the nearby city of Vidisha, a prosperous center in ancient Eastern Malwa. Emperor Ashoka, whose wife Devi was from Vidisha, played a key role in its development. The Sanchi hilltop provided an ideal setting for a monastery, offering a serene environment for meditation and spiritual practices.

MAJOR **ATTRACTIONS**

Udaigiri

Located only 16 kms away from Sanchi, the Udaigiri Caves offers a chance to witness stunning rock carvings. These 20 caves, consisting of 18 Hindu and 2 Jain caves, boast intricate religious iconography and sculpted stories dating back to the 4th and 5th centuries AD, created over several

generations.

Sanchi

Sanchi is famed for its ancient Buddhist site, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site, monasteries, temples and pillars dating from the 3rd century B.C. to the 12th century A.D. The Sanchi Stupa, the best known, was originally built by the Mauryan Emperor Ashoka is a prominent attraction for tourists. Sanchi is situated approximately 50 kms northeast of Bhopal, the capital city of Madhya Pradesh.

The establishment of Buddhist monuments at Sanchi is likely attributed to the city of Vidisha, the former capital of ancient Eastern Malwa, which was populous and prosperous. Emperor Ashoka's interest in Vidisha and its surroundings stemmed from the fact that his wife, Devi, hailed from Vidisha. Additionally, the hilltop of Sanchi provided an ideal setting for the establishment of monasteries, offering a conducive atmosphere for meditation and spiritual pursuits.



MAJOR **ATTRACTIONS**

Bhojpur

About 60 min drive from Bhopal will also take you on a tour to Bhojpur. Pay a visit to the enigmatic temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. It houses a huge shivlingam in its sanctum. It is believed that the construction of the temple was commenced during the reign of Paramara King-Bhoja.

Bhimbetka

Bhimbetka, an archaeological treasure, features around 243 rock shelters and holds the prestigious title of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The paintings discovered here bear a striking resemblance to those found in Kakadu National Park in Australia, the cave paintings of the Bushmen in the Kalahari Desert, and the Upper Palaeolithic Lascaux cave paintings in France. These rock shelters, which were inhabited by humans approximately 30,000 years ago, are surrounded by a rich flora and fauna, making Bhimbetka a remarkable legacy from our earliest ancestors. The Rock Shelters of Bhimbetka boast India's oldest-known rock art and comprise one of the largest prehistoric complexes in the region.



BHOPAL-UJJAIN-BHOPAL
